No high heels or flip flops please. Campers with longer hair should bring a hair tie to pull hair off of the face for movement workshops. 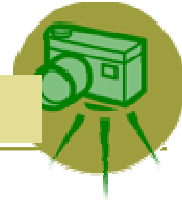
